

## INTERNATIONAL COUNCIL OF MARINE INDUSTRY ASSOCIATIONS

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### 1. DEFINITIONS

- 1.1** Delegate: the person stated on the Registration Form as being responsible for payment of the Conference Fee.
- 1.2** ICOMIA: means the Conference provider, International Council of Marine Industry Associations (registered number 420036724) whose registered office is Brigade Pironlaan 132, B-1080 Brussels, Belgium.
- 1.3** Conference: The First International Marine Hybrid Propulsion Conference.
- 1.4** Conference Fee: the fee charged by ICOMIA for a place on the Conference, as advertised by ICOMIA.
- 1.5** Registration Form: means the Registration Form for the relevant Conference.

#### 2. REGISTRATION

- 2.1** Registration Forms must be submitted with the full Conference Fee.
- 2.2** All Conference Fees are expressed as a VAT exclusive amount. The Conference Fee includes lunch and refreshments.
- 2.3** Registration Forms submitted without the relevant payment will not be processed until the payment is received.
- 2.4** Delegates will not be permitted to attend the Conference if the Conference Fee has not been paid in full by the last working day prior to the Conference commencement.
- 2.5** Places on the Conference are limited and will be allocated by ICOMIA on a "first come first served" basis. Submission of a Registration Form does not guarantee admission to the Conference.
- 2.6** ICOMIA will write to successful Delegates confirming their place on the Conference.

#### 3. CANCELLATIONS AND SUBSTITUTIONS

- 3.1** If ICOMIA cancels the Conference the Delegate will receive a full refund of the Conference Fee.
- 3.2** Should the Delegate wish to cancel the following cancellation charges will apply:-
- 56 and more days before date of Conference retention of 15% of Conference Fee.
  - Between 55 and 28 days before date of Conference 50% retention of Conference Fee.
  - Between 27 and 14 days before date of Conference 90% retention of Conference Fee.

d) Less than 14 days before date on Conference 100% retention of Conference Fee.

**3.3** Alternatively ICOMIA will allow the substitution of an alternative Delegate.

**3.4** ICOMIA reserves the right to amend the content of the Conference without notice when, in ICOMIA's opinion, such amendment does not fundamentally change the content of the Conference.

#### 4. EVENTS OUTSIDE OUR CONTROL

**4.1** ICOMIA will not be liable or responsible for any failure or delay or interruption in providing the Conference that is caused by events outside our reasonable control.

#### 5. COPYRIGHT

**5.1** The copyright in the Conference materials is owned by ICOMIA and other third parties, and Conference materials are licensed to Delegates for their own personal use, and not for re-use or re-sale.

#### 6. DATA PROTECTION

**6.1** We will use details of Delegates submitted on the Registration Form to inform them of future ICOMIA Conferences by e-mail, telephone, post and any other reasonable method. Delegates are asked to inform ICOMIA if they do not wish to receive this information.

#### 7. LIABILITY

**7.1** ICOMIA regrets that it cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to the property of the Delegate, or in relation to any death or personal injury. The Delegate is therefore advised to effect adequate insurance cover to cover these situations.

**7.2** ICOMIA will not be liable to the Delegate, whether in contract, tort, or otherwise for any:

- consequential loss;
  - indirect loss;
  - special loss;
  - incidental loss;
  - loss of profit;
  - loss of reputation;
- however so caused.

**7.3** ICOMIA will not be liable to the Delegate, whether in contract, tort, or otherwise for any sum greater than the sums paid by the Delegate to ICOMIA under the Conference Registration.

**7.4** ICOMIA reserves the right to pass any and all charges on to the Delegate for any charge made against it for the cost of rectifying damage, caused by a deliberate,

negligent or reckless act of the Delegate to any accommodation or venue or transport vehicle used by ICOMIA or its subcontractors in the provision of the Conference.

#### 8. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

**8.1** These terms and conditions and any document expressly referred to in them represent the entire agreement between ICOMIA and the Delegate in relation to the subject matter of these terms and conditions, understanding or arrangement between us, whether oral or in writing.
